Children can wear their own clothes day on Friday 30th November in exchange for a bottle. These will be used for the bottle tombola at the Christmas Fair.

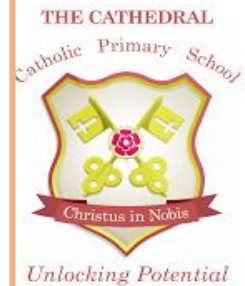
